Study Objectives


- Establish an historical (2010-2016) data base of available seeds (maize, rice and soy).
- Establish gaps within the value chain of breeder, foundation and certified seeds and from production to sales.
- Establish gaps between quantities demanded and quantities supplied.
- > Make projections for 40% certified seed coverage by 2018 in northern Ghana.










Foundation seed production (MT)

2017 SCALING-UP INTERVENTIONS

- > 70 seed producers have applied to produce seed across the three regions.
- ➤ Multiple 'Technology Fairs' to be conducted and 'Starter Packs' distributed
- ➤ 20 seed vans to be awarded to 20 seed producers for seed distribution and marketing
- ➤ 15 % loan contribution through selected banks for seed value chain activities
