COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT PARTNERS INFORMATION - N/R Introduction

The Northern Savannah Ecological Zone (NSEZ) occupies over 54.4% of the land space of Ghana and has been designated by the government as a breadbasket zone due to the vast farmlands and good soils for the production of stable crops. In an effort to tap into these economic resources of the NSEZ to partly reduce the poverty levels in the area as well as bridge the poverty gap between the north and the south, government after government have made policies to deliberately direct over 60% of donor interventions to the NSEZ.

Even though many and diverse actors are focusing on agriculture in the zone, their activities and actions remain uncoordinated, un-harmonized and nonaligned. This results in the duplication of actions and compromises efficiency and effectiveness whilst learning is lost. Following this, NSAICU was set up to provide effective coordination for increased development effectiveness and impact.

NSAICU has thus mapped up and compiled a database of all agriculture projects and investments in the zone as at December 2017. These partners are further brought onto the Regional Agriculture Sector Working Group (RASWG) on a bi-monthly basis to improve collaboration and cooperation amongst implementing partners. It also allows a discussion on field level implementation challenges, successes and lessons learnt.
